



DDBSA Award & Recognition Program

Top Owner-Handler Award

This award is presented to the DDBSA member Owner Handler who accumulates the most points, either dog or bitch, in the Dogue de Bordeaux AKC conformation ring from January 1st through December 31st.

Eligibility:

- Owner or co-owner must be a member in good standing of the Dogue de Bordeaux Society of America at the time the award is given.
- Points are awarded for NOHS BOB but no points are awarded for Group or BIS wins.
- Points are awarded as per AKC NOHS.
- Points are based on wins received at AKC licensed/member shows during a calendar year, January 1st through December 31st.
- An AKC Breed Dogs Defeated Report for application year must be submitted with the application.

General Rules:

- The Top Owner Handler Award application must be submitted no later than June 30th of the year in which the award may be given.
- This award will be presented at the National Specialty Show.
- The Awards Committee may recommend revisions to this program and revisions will be made by majority vote of the Dogue de Bordeaux Society of America Board of Directors. Notification of such revisions will be made to the membership on a timely basis.
